



ORDINANCE NO. 05-08

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT POLITICAL PARTIES
SHALL NOMINATE CANDIDATES FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICES
IN THE CITY OF NEWTON, JASPER COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/7-1(b) a City having a population of less than 5,000 may by ordinance determine that political parties shall nominate candidates for municipal office by primary in accordance with Article 7 of the Illinois Election Code, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the best interest of the City to adopt such an Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Jasper County, Illinois, as follows:

1. Political parties as defined in the Illinois Election Code shall nominate candidates for municipal offices in the City of Newton by primary in accordance with Article 7 of the Illinois Election Code.

2. The City Clerk shall certify this Ordinance to the proper election officials of Jasper County, Illinois.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
